Consumer Awareness Programme:-

During the program a meeting was conducted with the village chairman and other trade union and Chamber of Commerce Dimapur. After that the Training to village activities was covered in one Block (1) Dimapur Block. The block level meeting was conducted with the Monitor group and the beneficiaries block for the program. The DVD and CD program was conducted in the evening where all the village chairman and the Trade organization were present where the books were distributed. The book "Is It Really Safe?", the second in the series of publications on the theme of Caveat Emptor, meaning "Buyers Beware", is a compilation of articles on different safety aspects of various products and services. Vocational Training:-The vocational training centre is at Chumukidema Block under this programme 160 Women's and Youth has taken part every year for 6 (Six) Months courses and for another six months the organization selects beneficiaries from another Block. In the said programme, Department of Health and Family Welfare, Government of Nagaland, was significant. In these camps, treatment was provided particularly to women, children and the parent suffering from chronic ailments. In addition to this some patient were sent to health centre and district hospital. 580 persons took benefit from the campus. 1 Eye camp for community conducted with support from Department of Health and Family Welfare, Dimapur, in which 75 patient participated under which 08 persons get operated and 4 received spectacles and 63 got treatment (this kind of eye camp first time conducted in the areas).
